Fuel Container Phase Out

These containers **will not be in compliance** with direction found in the “Redbook” (Interagency Standards for Fire and Fire Aviation Operations—NFES 2724) after the indicated dates. Please plan accordingly for replacement.

June 2010



Tanks for gasoline or drip-torch fuel that do not meet U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) specifications. These tanks are acceptable for straight diesel.

June 2012



Plastic Fuel Containers, such as military-style plastic jerricans, consumer plastic containers, and plastic “Nalgene” fuel bottles. This prohibition does not include Dolmars.

June 2019



Drip Torches that do not meet DOT specifications.
