

A dangerous day in the woods, No Chevy's was injured in the production of this web page.

Take a close look at the face cut of this tree... The faller was trying to compensate for a lean in the tree by cutting to much of a notch.



The dollar bill is placed on this stump to show how small the back cut was before the tree started going over... **BACKWARD!**

This tree has done what is called a Barber Chair. Many times a Barber Chair will stay attached at the stump and ruin much of the log.



The result of this faller not using wedges to coax the tree into falling the way HE wants it to go, was costly AND dangerous!

This was a NICE early 90's crew cab Ford Truck. As fate would have it the faller of the tree was also the owner of the truck. If it had been me, my final payment would have been due the next day.
