Special Notes:

1. Normal care and vigilance is expected.
2. With appropriate permit.
3. Wood & charcoal in agency-provided sites (including Yellow-Post Sites).
4. Smoke in enclosed vehicles, developed recreation sites, or areas cleared 3 foot in diameter.
5. Gas and petroleum jelly stoves only with permit.
6. No tracer, armor-piercing, steel core, or Teflon® ammunition.
7. Designated shooting areas may be closed.
8. Spark arrestors required for off-road vehicles, chain saws, and other internal combustion equipment.
9. No shooting except as designated in the Forest Order.
10. No camping outside of developed and "Yellow Post" sites.
11. Some activities may be restricted. Check with local Forest Service stations.
