For final fire reports, the number of other structures that are declared destroyed are those when the fire report is completed. For SIT/209 reports, the number of other structures that are declared destroyed are those at the time of submission.</i> 4. <i>Other structures destroyed are not counted as residences destroyed or residences threatened.</i> 5. <i>Other structures destroyed are also counted as other structures threatened.</i>
