REMOVAL OF S-132 STANDARDS FOR SURVIVAL FROM THE PMS
October 5, 2004

BACKGROUND

The S-132, Standards for Survival course was developed in 1987 based on the Fire Orders in their revised format. In 2003 the Standard Firefighting Orders were returned to their original format, with some modifications. This reorganization of the Standard Firefighting Orders made S-132 outdated.

CURRENT STATUS


The content of S-132 was incorporated into the 2003 version of the S-130, Basic Firefighter course. The language in the PMS 310-1 was edited and approved by NWCG (see NWCG memo dated July 19, 2004: Replacement of Standards for Survival Language within the PMS 310-1).
