

Logging into NIFC ArcGIS Online (AGOL) and Starting NFDRS Application Access

1. Open an internet window using Internet Explorer or Chrome
2. Navigate to the NIFC (National Interagency Fire Center) AGOL site
<http://nifc.maps.arcgis.com/home/index.html>



3. (If needed) Request a NIFC AGOL account on the NIFC (National Interagency Fire Center) AGOL site by clicking on the button "Request a NEW Account".




Note: For USFS folks, a NIFC AGOL account is different from a USFS AGOL account. The NIFC AGOL account is to be used with anything pertaining to wildland fire incidents.

4. If you already have a NIFC AGOL account, then click on the "Sign In" link in the upper right-hand corner of the NIFC AGOL site page.


