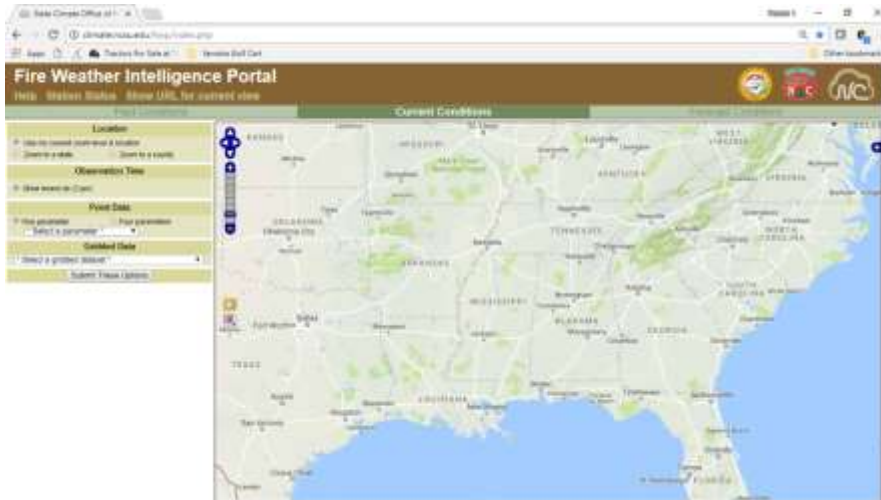

The Fire Weather Intelligence Portal was designed as a “one-stop shop” for wildland fire decision-making and provides a format for coalescing and assessing critical fire weather information. It is a web-based monitoring tool that was originally developed to show past, current, and forecast weather and fire risk information across North Carolina and has now been expanded to cover 13 states! Its updated informational packages contain critical fire weather and fire danger information that is available 24/7. This information helps prescribed burners and wildfire suppression personnel more easily assess daily burning and smoke dispersion conditions.
