

How to Export a GeoPDF from EGP Situation Analyst

In Situation Analyst, zoom to the extent where you would like create a map.



Open the **Manage Layers** tab.



Click the **Advanced Settings** button.



Click **Export Layers**.



1. Toggle On or Off any optional layers.
2. Enter all emails to send the map to.
3. Title the map appropriately and click **Export** to create the map.

Open the email you will receive on your mobile device, click **View Geospatial PDF**. Click the option to **Open in Avenza Maps**. The map will load to Avenza. (If you have the trial version of Avenza, you will need to delete a map first if you already have three)
