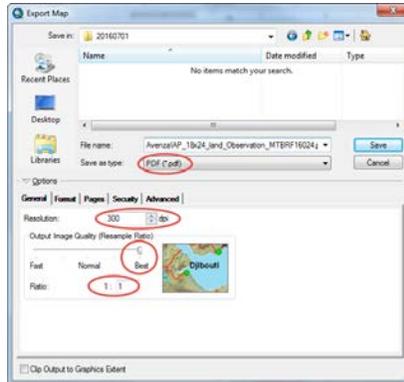
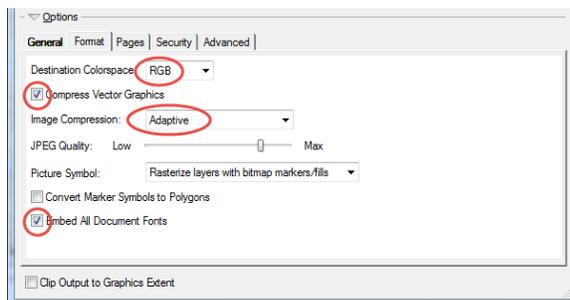


Geospatial PDF “One Page”

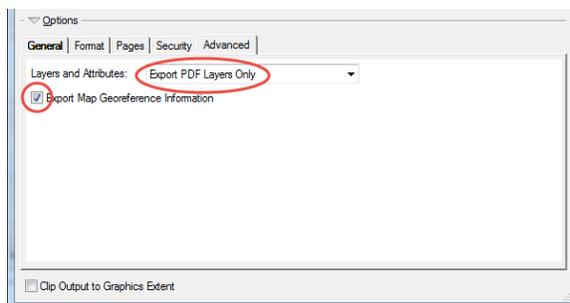
1. Create map in ArcMap or ArcGIS Pro. Keep basemap, “page size”, and map scale in consideration. Confirm all standard map elements (STANDL SGD) are present.
2. In ArcMap:
 - a. Go to **File** → **Export Map...**
 - b. General Tab:



- c. Format Tab:



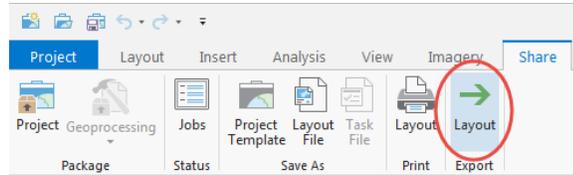
- d. Advanced Tab:



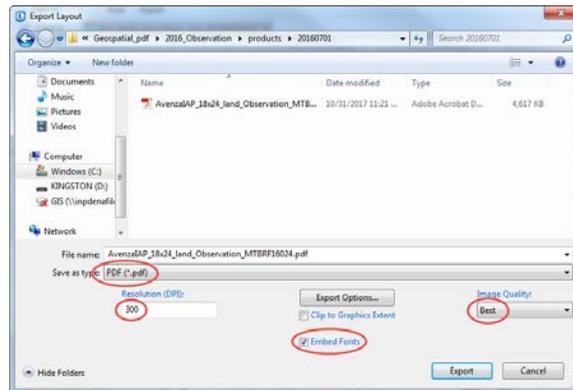
- e. Click **Save** to create the geospatial PDF.

3. In ArcGIS Pro:

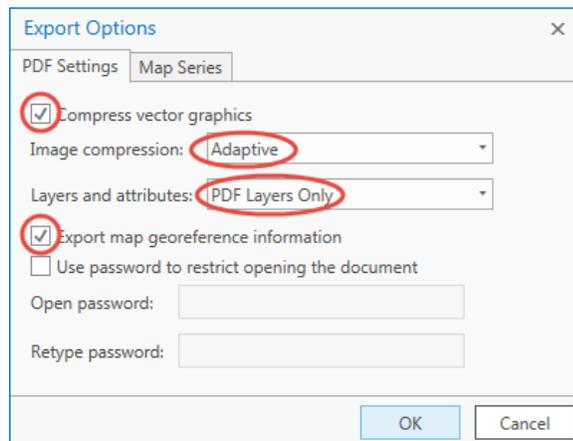
- a. Make sure that the map or layout is the active view and then click on the **Share** tab → then in the **Export Group** → click “**Map**” or “**Layout**” (Depending on the active view)

c. Export Options Window:



- d. Click **OK** and **Export** to create the geospatial PDF.

4. Compress the geospatial pdf using either Adobe Acrobat Pro (if it is installed on your computer), or a free online compression tool such as <https://smallpdf.com/>.
5. Upload the compressed geospatial PDF to a mobile device and open using the Avenza Maps App to test the appearance and functionality. It may take several attempts to get the correct balance of page size, scale, and output settings.
