<p>The FCAT White Paper was presented and approved by NWCG and FMB. Both groups supported FCAT development to determine Interagency Dispatch Center’s budget allocation. The implementation of a standard interagency costing tool will benefit the federal wildland fire agencies/bureaus, tribes, states and local governments. A national standardized process will enable management to look at the entire dispatch/coordination system from a workload and budget perspective. Some preliminary work has begun to organize and evaluate independent models such as Fire Org, Rocky Mtn. Area (Carter, Poirier), and Southwest Area.</p> <p>NCSC would like WFIT to assist in developing a FCAT that would be utilized by local dispatch centers and geographic/national coordination centers.</p>
